MALAYSIAN PROTECTION OF NEW PLANT VARIETIES ACT 2004


- Several sessions of revision were conducted.

Number of Applications Received 2008 – 2015 (by Crop Type)



FORUM DIRECTION


→ To establish cooperation between ASEAN Member States in developing an efficient regional plant variety protection system and move towards ASEAN bloc.
