


1. Plant Variety Protection in Malaysia

MALAYSIAN PROTECTION OF NEW PLANT VARIETIES ACT 2004

- Protect all plants but excludes microbes.
- Implemented – 20 Oct 2008



STRUCTURE OF PVP SYSTEM







Number of Applications Received 2008 – 2013 (by Crop Type)





Number of Application (by Crop Type) (2008 – 2013)




Number of PVP Applications by Nationality








