✓ Enacted - at 20th January 2016

(The Pyidaung Su Hluttaw Law No.15, 2016) enforced at 20th January 2017)

- Amending the existing PVP Law in line with the UPOV 1991
- (technical assistances of the UPOV lawyers and Myanmar AGO Lawyers in two times 6th December 2016 & 17th January 2017)
- On Going process to amend the existing PVP Law



Crop: Rice (103) & Maize (96)



Cha; 21,22,23 – Lemma; Anthocyanin coloration of apex, below apex, keel




Cha; 12- Leaf: color of ligule


