



- Fruit: color of the surface red
- Spinterns: color of the apex green
- Spinterns: color of the base red
- Pulp: texture firm crispy

Breeding and Collection Program of Rambutan in Thailand


Carried out by Horticultural Research Institute, Department of Agriculture

Sreeding program started in 1979 resulting 8 hybrids : 3 distinguished varieties ; Prew no.1, Prew no. 2 and Prew no.3 or Chanthaburi (recommended variety by DOA)

Three Collection Fields located in Chantaburi Province (The East) Suratthani Province and Trung Province (The South)


