

Report for PVP Study Tour in Vietnam

【Date】 7.11.2017 – 10.11.2017

【Main objective】

To study administrative and technical procedure of Plant Variety Protection System of Vietnam to assist for the implementation of PVP system in Myanmar.

【Agenda】

Nov. 7 : Introduction of the process from filing to the granting of PVP Certificate

Place - PVP office, Department of Crop Production (DCP), Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development

Study contents - Receiving application – Record the data – Examination of the validity of application – Publication of accepted applications – Examination of the content of application (when receiving the DUS Test report from National Center or others) – Decision of granting the Certificate/Decision to refuse of granting Certificate – Publication of the Decision (one month) – Granting the Certificate.



Nov. 8 : Study Visit to Tuliem Station (Upland Crops, DUS and VCU test station)

<Morning session>

Place- Tuliem Station which is situated far from about 10 km from DCP

Study contents - Introduction of implementation for DUS Growing Test in the Station; the relation between the Station and National Center for Plant Testing (NCPT) and PVPO in the DUS Test. Field visit of maize growing field

<Afternoon session>

Place - National Center of Plant Testing (NCPT), DCP

Study contents - Introduction on the role of leading for DUS Test of NCPT, routine works in the field of DUS Test. Introduction of Database on new varieties

Nov. 9 : Study Visit to Van Lam Station (rice DUS Test)

<Morning session>

Place - Van Lam Station

Study contents - Introduction of implementation for DUS Growing Test in the Station; the relation between the Station and National Center for Plant Testing(NCPT) and PVPO in the DUS Test and practical exercise for characterization of rice (candidate and similar varieties) and data analysis on the collected data

<Afternoon session>

Place - Fruit and Vegetable Research Institute

Study contents - Introduction of the Institute (Research Activities for Breeding and Cultural Practices of Vegetable and Fruits and Research achievements), Studying tomato research farm and learning high technology for tomato Production



Nov. 10 : Introduction of How to examine the content of application

Place - PVP office, DCP

Study contents - DUS Test Report and Denomination, Electronic application procedure system, DUS testing procedure (at DUS station, buying test report from other UPOV member countries, examining in breeder filed)
