


Percentage Area Classified by Type of Land (2022-2023)


### National Gross Domestic Products (GDP) (2022-2023)








#### **Current Seed Sector**

- 2. Informal seed system (95%) (Farmer saved & exchanged: local sale)
- 3. Intermediary seed system (less dominant) (Public-Private)

#### **Seed Multiplication Procedure**




**Formal Seed Production System**











#### **Objectives**

- to promote local and foreign investment in the plant breeding activity
- □ to support the development of the national economy through utilization of new plant varieties for production



#### **Organizational Structure of DAR**






PVPO is not authorized, only media/ agent for communication between NPVPC, TPVPC and applicants

#### Procedure for application of new variety to get PBR




- Number of persons in charge and examiners 24 (trained persons)




