



New Items of Variety Database

Part of new law has been enforced from April 1, 2021 (Following information published by official gazette)

13	Prohibiting the actinon of export	Yes
14	Designated State where export applicable	None
15	Prohibiting the action of production

Plant Variety Protection and Seed Act Article 21-2 (Special Provisions on the Limitation of the Effects of the Breeder's Right)

- (1) A person who intends to obtain a variety registration may, in the cases listed in the following items, file to the Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries a notification describing the matters specified in the said items at the same time as the application for the variety registration pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance of the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, in order to secure the appropriate exercise of the breeder's right pertaining to the said variety registration.
 - (i) in cases of preventing the propagating material of the said applied variety from flowing out to other States where the applicant believes that the measures to protect applied varieties might not be taken, the following matters;
 - (a) a State designated by the applicant as a State where appropriate measures to protect the said applied variety will be taken (excluding the States prescribed in the proviso of Article 21, paragraph (2)) (hereinafter referred to as "designated State");
 - (b) the intention of prohibiting the act of exporting propagating material or harvested material for purposes other than final consumption to the States other than designated States (excluding the States prescribed in the proviso of Article 21, paragraph (2)) without authorization
 - (ii) in cases of forming a production area of the applied variety, the following matters;
 - (a) an area designated by the applicant as a production area of the said applied variety (hereinafter referred to as "designated area");
 - (b) the intention of prohibiting the act of producing harvested materials obtained through the use of the propagating material in an area other than the designated area without authorization



Electronic Application System for Plant Variety Protection

After March 26, 2018, applicants can apply an application form as well as payment for application and registration fee electronically. Electronic Payment for registration is also accepted for the plant varieties which were registered in the past by paper.



Note:

Language: Applications (application form and attached documents) must be made (written or translated) in Japanese only. Postal address for receiving user-ID: Applicants need to designate a mailing address in Japan to receive "User-ID" by mail. Bank account: To use "Pay-Easy", a bank account in Japan is necessary.

Outline of Electronic Application System for PVP (EAS)

Electronic Application

- Enter user ID and password of an applicant on the EAS located in the MAFF website, and enter necessary information on the electronic application form. Upload documents.
- Save the entry and click the application button. The data will be then sent to MAFF.
- Pay the application fee; JPY 14,000 by using the Pay-Easy (through Internet- Banking, ATM)
 with notified necessary information (payment number etc.). The application filing to be
 completed after the payment.
- The EAS has been operating since 2018.
- The EAS is under development to be linked with UPOV PRISMA. After the machine-to-machine communication meet with success, applicants will be able to submit the application through e-PVP Asia application module.

Payment for Registration Fee

- The Fee for the registration can also be made by logging in the EAS (multi-year payment is also available).
- Electronic Payment for registration is also accepted for the plant varieties which were registered in the past by paper.

Issue of "Log-in ID"

- For using the MAFF EAS, applicants need to acquire "Log-in ID" and "Password" in advance.
- The applicant who wishes to use EAS needs to download "application form for the log-in ID" from MAFF PVP office website, and send the filled-out form by postal mail to the indicated address (e-mail and fax are not accepted).

Japanese Status in UPOV PRISMA

- Japanese is available as "Navigation Language" in the PRISMA system.
- Japan has not yet started to accept application to Japan through the PRISMA.

^{*1:} Applicant can select "Navigation Languages" on web screen. The navigation languages (translated from original languages) supports applicants to fill up application form. The system send data to the applied country (participating country) using "Output form Languages", which is designated by the applied country.
