1. National goal (10-year strategic plan 2018-2027)

- To strengthen PVP system to raise awareness of Plant breeder's right (PBR) and to promote breeding activities of new varieties
- To increase number of PVP application
- To become the basis for references, manifestations and policies in planning, implementing and evaluating the success of development implementation in national seed industry and plant varieties.

2. Objectives with analysis of challenges (for next 3 years)

Challenges:

- Lack of awareness of importance and utilization of PVP
- Stagnation in number of applications for PVP in Indonesia (around 50 varieties every year)
- There are some inharmonious seed regulations other than PVP.

Objectives (2023-2025):

- Improve PVP services to stakeholders to strengthen national administrative procedures for implementing PVP system from filing of application to granting rights
- Compiling an inventory list of PVP problems in regulation (review existing law of PVP).
- Development new DUS testing station (low-medium land) in Bogor, West Java

3. Planned activities and Road map (for next 3 years)

- Legal Analysis/ Study of UPOV membership
- FGD Strengthening the UPOV Indonesia Membership Plan with the Penta helix approach involving 5 (five) elements of Government, Academics, Industry or business entities, society or communities, and Media.

4. Proposal of Cooperation Activity (Members who submitted proposals ONLY. The proposals will be presented with explanation of relevance to its 10-YSP.)

- Study Analysis: Legal Analysis in Strengthening the Plan of Indonesia UPOV Membership.
